- 246-10. Councillor Joseph D. Solomito, to amend the Code of the City of Fitchburg, section 169-54, subsection C (resident only parking permits) to read as follows:
 - a. Cedar St.-both sides from Pearl St. northerly and southerly for 350 feet.
 - b. Pacific St.-both sides from Pearl St. northerly and southerly for 350 feet.
